Youth will be able to complete an Introduction to Leadership (Quarterdeck Training) for Sea Scout Ships (LSSS) as mandated by the National Sea Scout Training for Quarterdeck. This is a 3 module course interactive program for Skippers to provide newly elected and appointed Sea Scouts with initial training on their responsibilities, and to equip them with leadership and management abilities to effectively run their ship. Shortly after the ship's annual election, it's strongly recommended the Skipper facilitate this training along with the mate and ship's youth leadership, collectively known as the quarterdeck.

Adults will be able to complete training, committee meeting and / or cruise planning.
