There is no need to mail the original application and photo.

Successful applicants will receive notification with instructions to arrange and pay for their own transportation to and from embarkation and debarkation sites. It is recommended that you travel on fully refundable tickets; CGC EAGLE is a military vessel and its schedule is subject to change due to operational commitments or weather.

Note: The dates provided above are still to be approved by the USCG, and week 3 may be the best time for maximum Sea Scout participation.

IMPORTANT NOTICE CONCERNING FOOD ALLERGIES AND DIETARY RESTRICTIONS:

Please do not apply for this program if you have food allergies or special dietary restrictions. CGC EAGLE is a military vessel with a military galley (kitchen). There are no provisions to accommodate personnel or guests with food allergies or special dietary restrictions; nor may personnel or guests bring their own food. The medical facilities aboard CGC EAGLE are very limited; a severe allergic reaction while at sea would be life threatening for the patient and diversion to shore-side medical resources would disrupt the ship's training mission.

In addition to transportation, candidates will need to plan to pay for their meals aboard CGC EAGLE (about \$85) and clothing items (about \$75).

UNIFORM REQUIREMENT: You must have a complete New Century Universal Uniform (Official Sea Scout Uniform) exactly as described in the 2016 *Sea Scout Manual*, to wear when you board and depart CGC EAGLE.
